

At 92 years of age Irving P. Fraleigh was buried on December 9, the first bitter day of the Winter. Irv was one of a kind, a cattle dealer of the old school. When he wanted to buy a helifer he wanted to buy her right, even if the owner was reluctant to sell. If necessary he would hector the owner, reduce him to tears, at which point a proper deal was made.

In spite of his native ferocity, Mr. Fraleigh was a man who was always forgiven the next day. His father was one of the best loved men in Red Hook at the turn of the century. His son of the same name carries on the dairy business and will share his loss with all those who have lived on the land.
