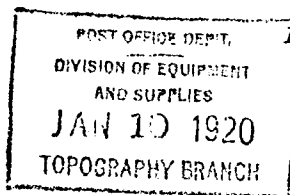
The name of the nearest office on my route, on the other side, is Pine Plains

The post-office building is on the West side of the New York Central Railroad,
and at a distance of 3 miles from the track.

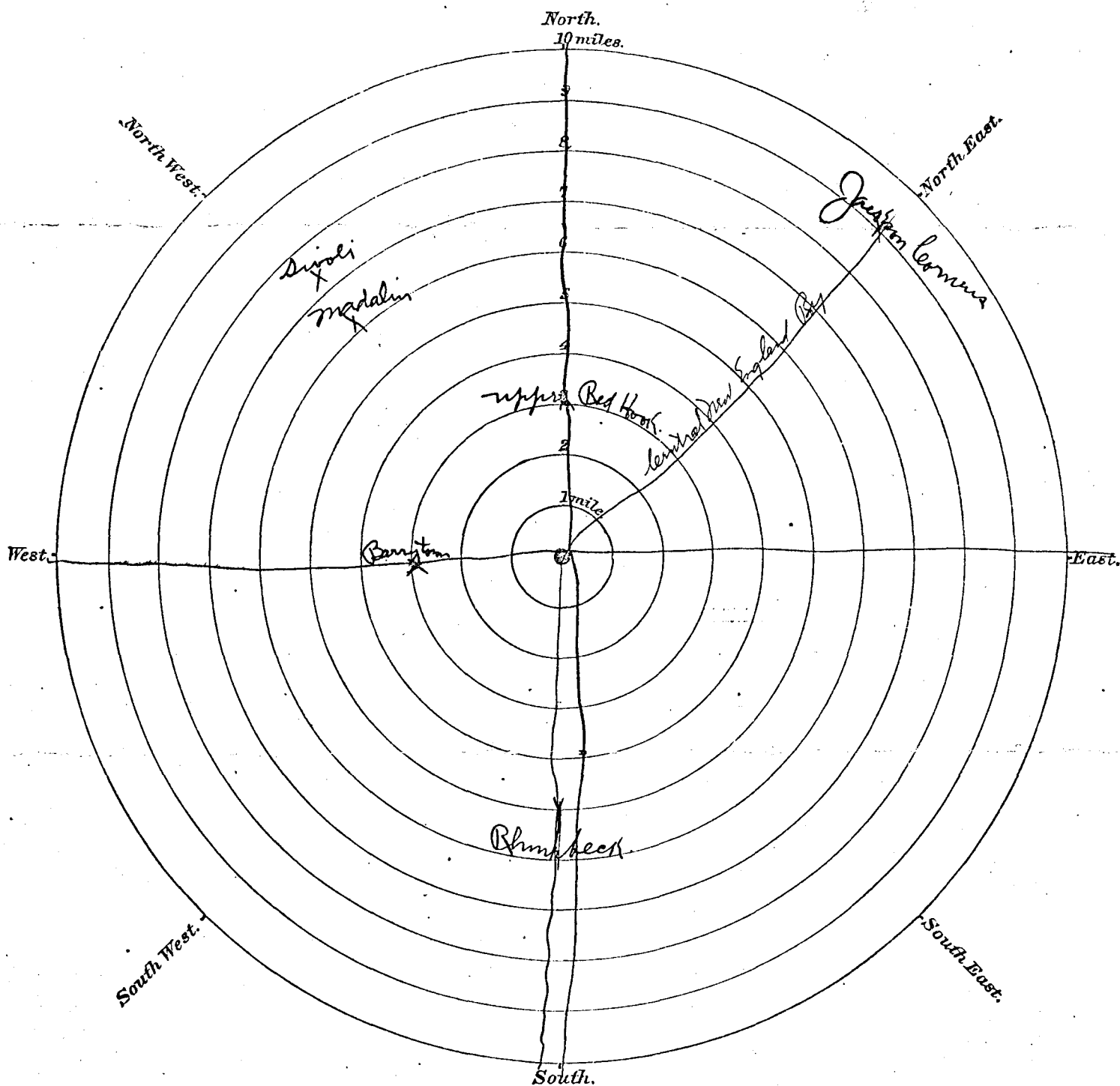
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DIAGRAM, EXPLANATION, AND INSTRUCTIONS.

The dot in the center of the 1-mile circle represents the site of the post office.
 The surrounding offices should be carefully located by placing dots on or between the mile circles at the exact distance, and in the right direction, from the post office, and their names plainly written.
 Draw distinctly the railways, roads, rivers, and creeks.

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
