The Red Church (Red Church of Tivoli) (Old Red Hook Church)

1766 "Church Book of the Congregation of Roode Hoek" in Dutch (membership lists found in blue loose-leaf notebook)

Received into membership...

1803 – Peter St. Paul, free African

Note: Per Roger Leonard: Freed in 1797 by Peter Cantine (Whalesback by Kirtley Lewis, 1942)

1807 - Richard, a slave of Col. Deveaux and his wife, Mary, a slave of Col. Elmendorph

1808 – Sarah, a slave of P. Ryphenburg

1811 – Hannah, a slave of Mrs. Hermance

1820 – Diana, a colored woman

1821 – Nancy, a colored woman of G. Cuck, wife of Jabez Davis

1823 – Simon Feller, a man of color

1824 – Peter, a colored man

1812 – Francis Simpson to Betsey Livingston, domestics of Gen H. Livingston

1813 – Tom, Bet. Servants of Gen Ten Brouk

1815 – Thomas Peterson to Sally Baker, both servants of John Livingston

1823 – Simon Williams, colored man of John Feller to Diana Alexander, colored woman

1823 – Harry Fraleigh, colored to Betty Masten, colored

1825 – Isaac Thomson, colored to Rosette, colored

1853 – Henry Ellsworth Jackson, colored, Milan to Eliza Jane Thompson, colored, Milan

1854 – Thomas H. Martin, colored, Red Hook to Eliza Jane Howe, colored, Red Hook

1856 – Thomas Jefferson, colored, Red Hook to Maria Thompson, colored, Milan

1863 – Lemuel Jackson, colored, Milan to Sarah Thompson, colored, Red Hook

1865 – Stephen St. Paul, colored, Milan to Eliza Hubbard, colored, Hyde Park
1865 – Albert Falbott, colored, late of Virginia contraband to Jane Thompson, Red Hook
1887 – John Van Buren, colored, West Camp, N.Y. to Sarah L. Jefferson, colored, Upper Red Hook

Slave of Robert Livingston (no name), Mother - Maria
Slave of Mickel Rau, Illegitimate child (no name), Mother – Gertaraut, Father – last name Rauen
Slave of Robert Livingston, no name, Father's first name - Johannes
