

RED HOOK, N. Y. WATER WORKS.

NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS.

Sealed proposals will be received by the Board of Water Commissioners of the Village of Red Hook, N. Y., at their office in said village, until 2 o'clock p. m., on the 9th day of July, 1895, for the material and labor required to construct water works in the village of Red Hook. Proposals must be made on blanks furnished by the Commissioners. The right is reserved to reject any and all proposals. Blank bids and specifications can be obtained of the Water Commissioners, and plans will be exhibited by them ten days prior to the day of letting.

Proposals will be received for the Cast Iron Pipe and special castings, for the Hydrants, Stop Valves and Boxes, for the Pumps and Boilers, for the Stand Pipe, for the Pump House, for the Well, or for the work complete, in separate bids as provided in the specifications. The annexed blank form must be used in making the bid and the prices must be both in writing and figures. The person or persons to whom the contract may be awarded must appear at the office of the Board of Water Commissioners, with the securities offered (said securities to be satisfactory to the Commissioners), to execute the contract, within five days after notice of award.

The amount of security will be from one-fourth to two-thirds the amount of the contract, to be determined by the Commissioners.
