7 March 1895 Benjamin Teats to Ella Teats Parcel located on the East side of North Broadway known as the Schultz property Bounded by North by Elizabeth B. Martin (formerly Joseph Martin) East by Howard Ellsworth and Mrs Alfred Folmsbee South by Electrus Teats and Jabob W. Elseffer West by highway North Broadway

24 June 1895 Julia E.Schultz to Benjamin Teats ouse and lot bounded by North by Joseph Martin  
East by A. Folmsbee and H. Ellsworth  
South By E. Teats  
Containing about 1 acre of land

1 May 1903 Ella Teats to Cameron R. Traver, Ambrose E. Traver and Ralph W. Traver Bounded on North by Elisabeth B. Martin, Harriet A. Martin & Sarah S. Larkin formerly Joseph Martin Deceased  
East By Howard Ellsworth  
South by lands of party of first part  
West By North Broadway

29 Dec 1919 Jennie Traver and Alice Shook to Ambrose E. raver and Ralph E. Traver Same dimensions as above  
Said premises being subject to a perpetual leasehold and annual ground rent of \$12.50 owned by and payable to James S. Armstrong and Estate of Henry Beekman Armstrong, deceased, heirs of land Henry B. Armstrong

12 May 1922 William S. Massonneau Exec of James S. Armstrong to Ambrose E. Traver and Ralph W. Traver  
Parcel of alnd formerly owned by Benjamin D. Schultz bounded  
East by Katherine E. Adams, formerly Jacob W. Elseffer, formerly Jacob Whitman  
South by Ella Teats formerly Electrus Teats  
West by Post Road  
North by lands of heirs of Joseph Martin  
Intention of deed to convey all right, title and interest

4 May 1939 Ruth G. Tremper individually to Stanton R. Tremper  
In a deed 6 Nov 1925 from Ralph W. Traver and wife to Stanton R. Tremper and Harold O Tremper  
Dimensions same as above but excepting 2 parcels of 0.08 acres each

5 Nov 1925 Ralph W. Traver and Mary his wife to Stanton R. Tremper of ed Hook and Harold O. Tremper  
Same dimemnsions as above including the exception of two parcels

6 Nov 1922 American Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals to Ambrose E. Traver and Ralph W. Traver  
Same as first deed above and conveys all right and title to parcels

Mortgage 7 Nov 1925 Stanton R. Tremper, Harold O. Tremper and others to Rhinebeck Savings Bank \$8000

26 September 1922 Ambrose E. Traver and Louise his wife to Ralph W.E. Traver  
Same premises taken from deed of Jennie Traver and Alice Shook to Ambrose E. Traver and Ralph W. E. Traver dated 29 Dec 1919

4 May 1939 Ruth G. Tremper and A. Lee Stickle, Executors of Harold O. Tremper to Stanton Tremper  
To the good will of the garage and sales business at the village of Red Hook known as Central Auto Sales Co.
