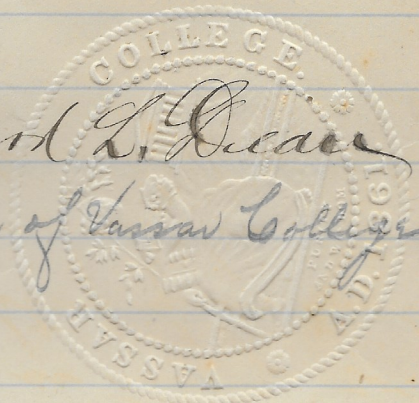
Vassar College correcting its release to Mary Harbrouck
