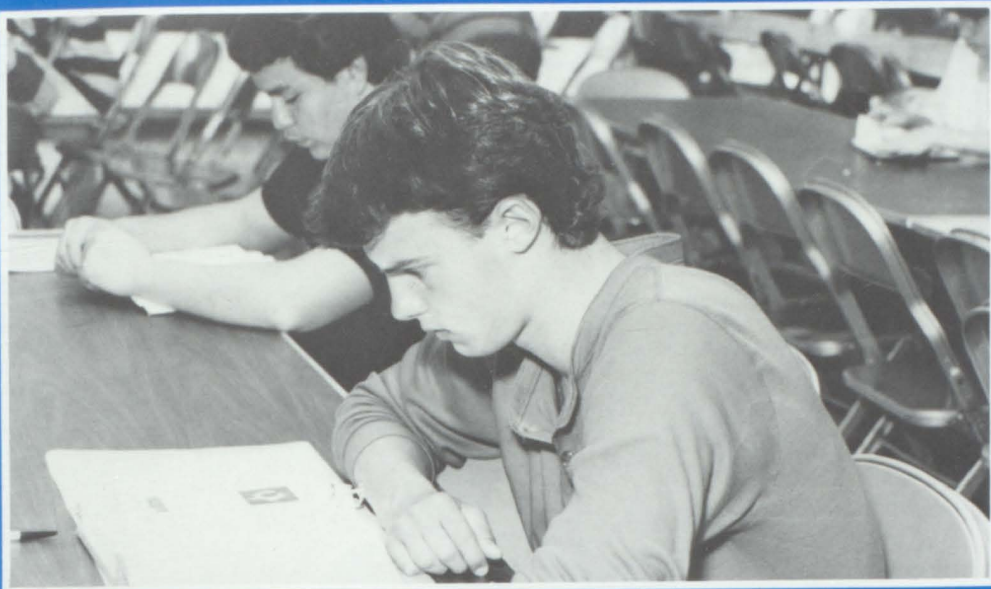
# UGH!

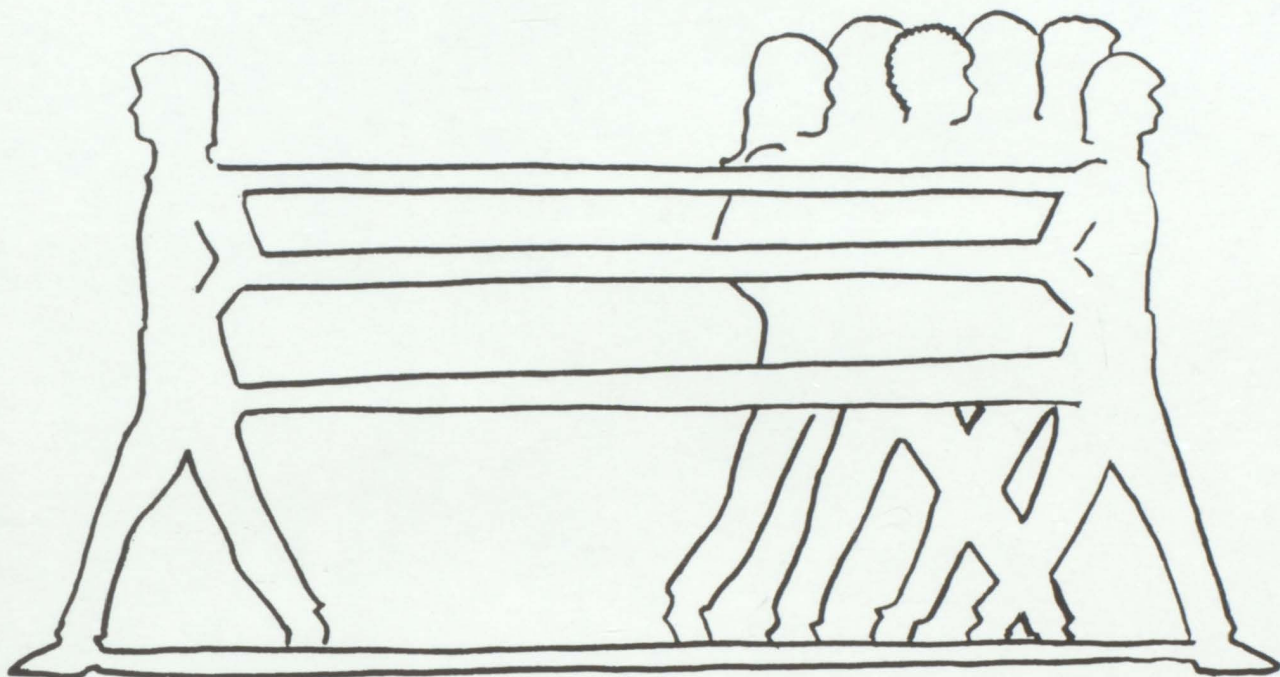


# DEDICATION

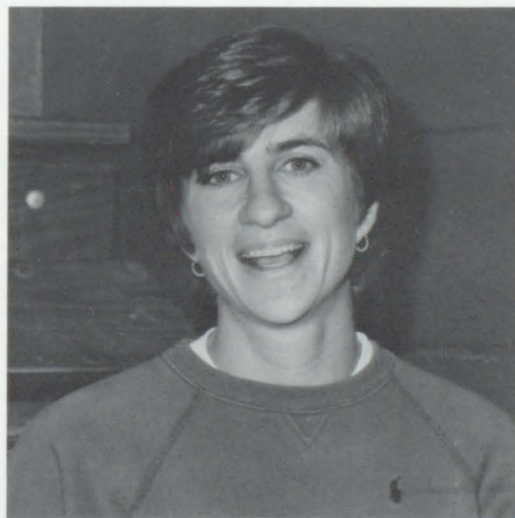

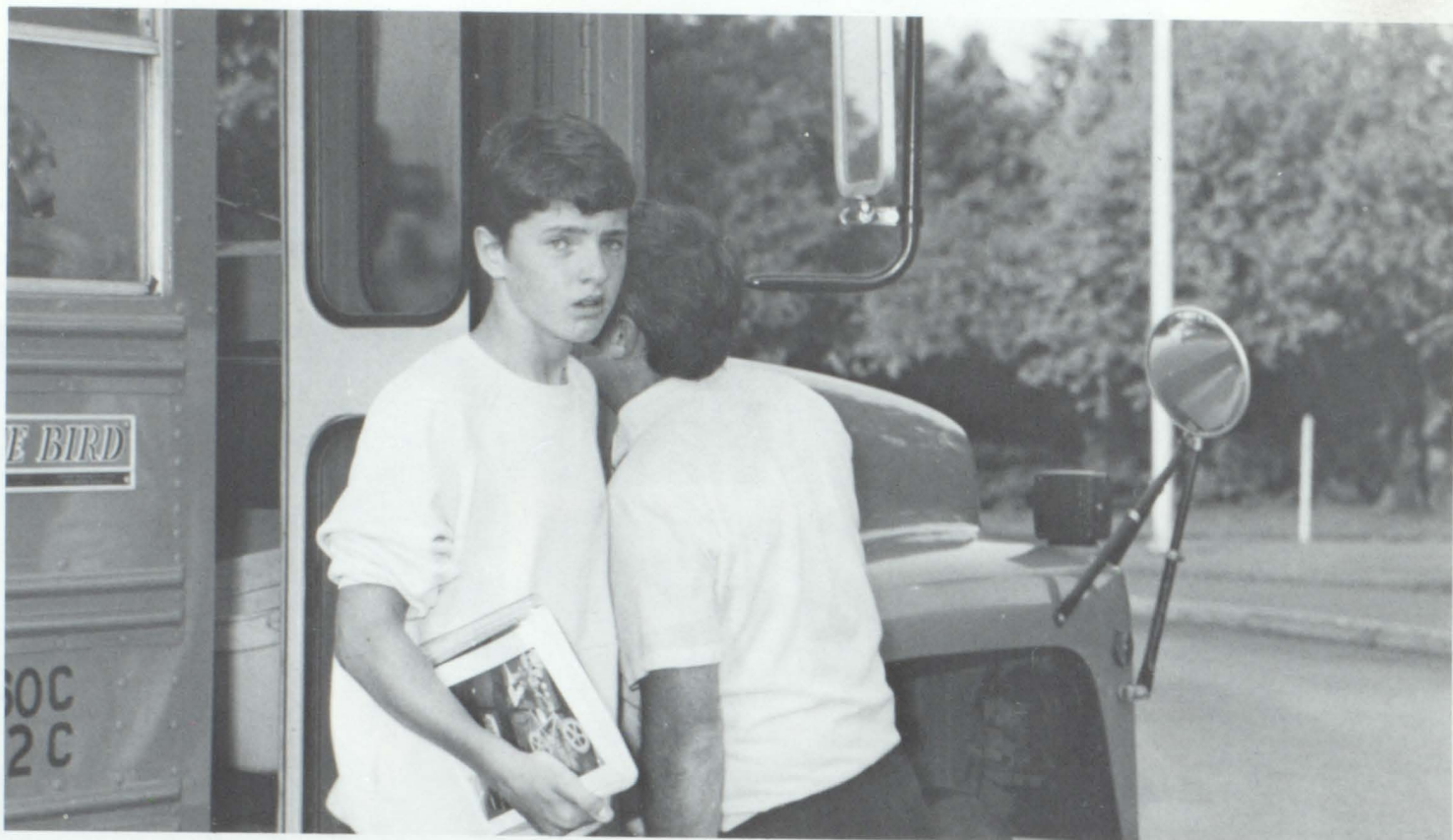
## CABARET

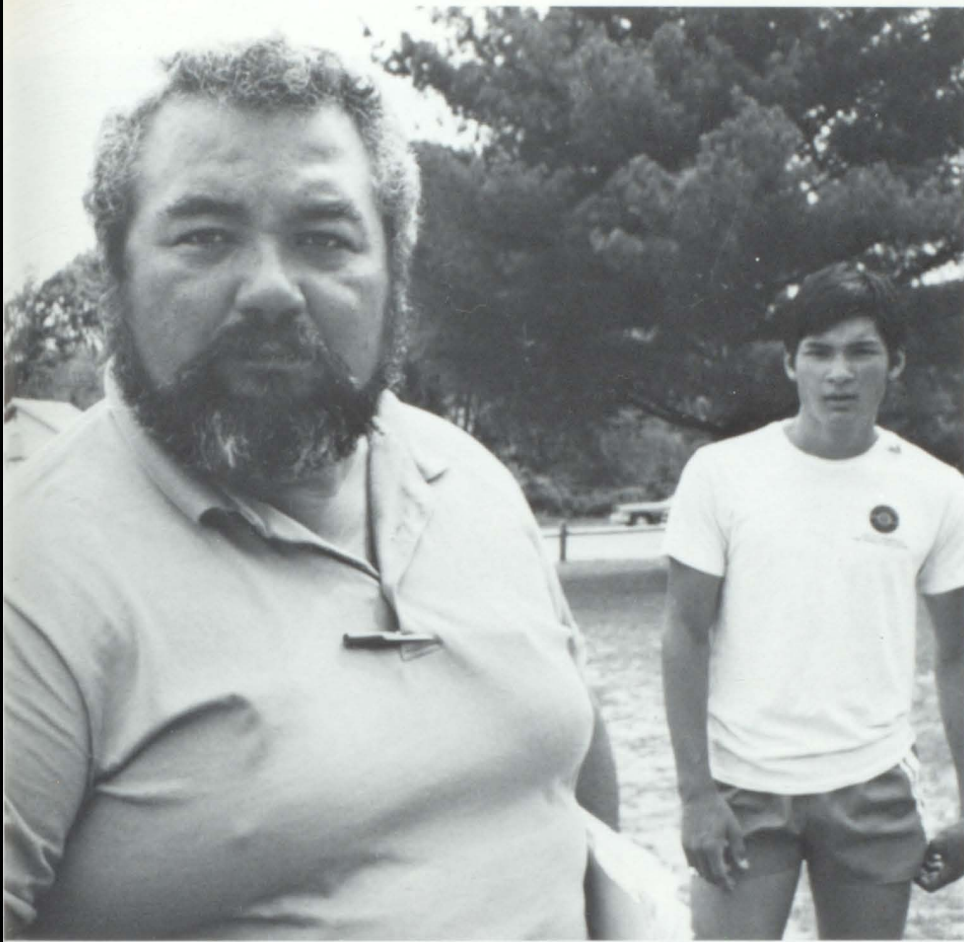
In the girls' team, Cathy Gordineer was in the 4 X 1 relay and the 100 hurdles, making her a double winner along with Toni Cincotta.

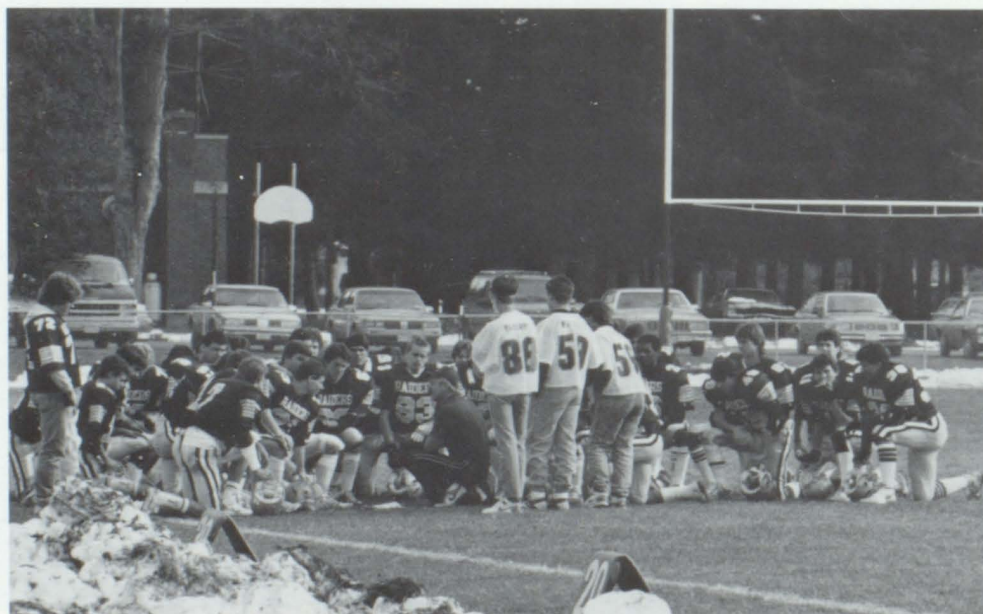
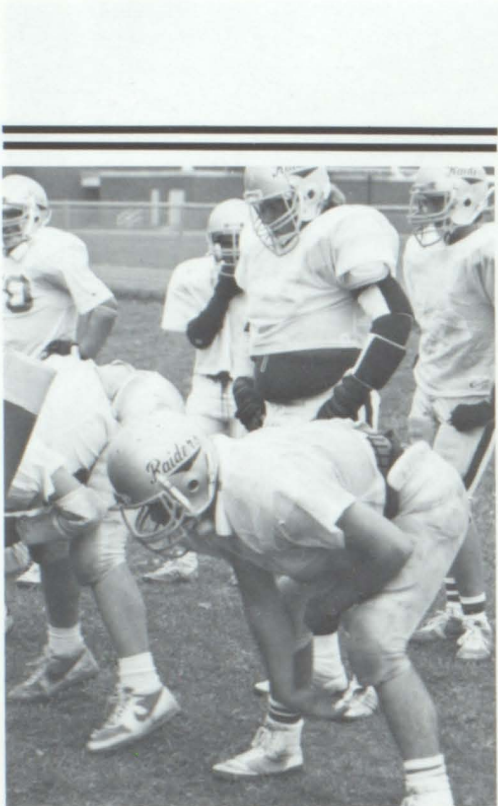
