This collection represents a branch of the Teator family descended from Johan Dother Teeter. The siblings were:

- 1) Kathleen Agnes Teator 1906-1994 (married Benson Lewis Becker)
- 2)Robert Sylvester Teator 1898-1971 (m. Olive Sagendorf 1904-1994) Sons Ronald Teator (1929-2018) and Norman Teator
- 3) Harry Teator 1895-1975 m Anna Mae Balsam
- 4) Frank Teator 1894-1983 m Kathleen Griffing
- 5) Cora Mary Teator 1891-1978
- 6) Dorothy Irene Teator 1909 -

Three siblings lived on the farm. Robert lived in the house now at 33 (?) Echo Valley Road. Harry lived in what is now the Totten house. Frank lived there earlier? (see Emily's EVF report). Robert and Olive lived in what became Ron's house – 33 ?Echo Valley Road. Cora lived at the end of Echo Valley Road.
