Background Information: This collection was given by Mrs. Charlotte Bathrick. Mrs. Arvine (Charlotte) Bathrick was the last Secretary of the Historical Club of Upper Red Hook, an organization founded in 1901 for the purpose of studying "World Wide Subjects" The collection includes minute books, histories, bylaws and a complete run of yearbooks which document the officers, the members and papers presented during the 90 years of the Clubs existence.
