Dear Mr. Ososky :-

In regard to your letter concerning the bull and Irving Fraleigh, George still hasent been able to get a job. He had worked the fall before last hauling apples for cider, but last spring we had several late frosts and spoiled most all the apples so he did not get much work and at the same time George had to move his whole farm alone so did not get much time to haul apples. Just recently he had $\frac{1}{2}$ days work 3 or 4 times trucking cider apples but could not as yet get anything steady.

If we have a good apple year this year he will make an arrangement with you to pay Irv. for the bull. Because of

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having worked on the farm he was not eligible for much unemployment insurance except for the short time he hauled apples but had to stop to move as he did all the moving alone.

The Unemployment Office has not had any jobs so George has been going to all the trucking firms around Albany and has several promises as soon as the trucking opens up.

I am having a hard time trying to keep everything going just on my husbands Social Security as he went totally blind and had to quit work before he was 65. I am 67 and have to have a Hysterectomy operation because of carrying heavy pails of water back to the calves every day so I cannot get a job myself.

I cannot get the operation as yet either as we are still paying for my husbands operation. He had gone totally blind and had the operation and got part sight back in one eye but the other is still totally blind. On top of being blind he was in a deep depression and George + myself had a terrible time with him.

Please explain to Mrs Fraleigh that we are not doing this purposely as we had been dealing with him for many years and never cheated him. yet. and I promise as soon as he gets working steady he will be in touch with you and with the promises of jobs he has got I don't think it will be too long.
