Addition to Ward Manor Opens.

The New York Association for Improving the Condition of the Poor will open an additional building today for the permanent care of elderly persons on its property in Dutchess County, six miles north of Rhinecliff. The property, formerly owned by L. Gordon Hamersly, was purchased two years ago by William B. Ward in behalf of the Robert Boyd Ward Fund and turned over to the association. The addition will increase the capacity by thirty-one single rooms, all promised to waiting guests. Its cost was \$100,000. There will now be seventy-five persons living at Ward Manor.
