

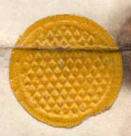
This Indenture made this 9th day
of August 1862 between John Tralagh of
the Town of Red Hook County of Dutchess
and State of New York of the first part
and John E. Lodge of the same
place party of the second part
Witnesseth That the said party of the
first part for and in consideration of
the sum of five dollars to him in hand
paid by said party of the second part
doth hereby grant bargain sell & convey
with the said party of second part
and to his heirs and assigns forever
a right of way in and over the south
part where the road now is of a lot of
land in the village of Upper Red Hook town
& County aforesaid, for the said party
of the second part his heirs & assigns
forever his & their servants & tenants at
all times to freely pass & re-pass on foot
or with horses oxen & cattle beasts of burden
whegs, carts sleighs or other vehicle or carriage
whosoever from the highway to the lands
of the said party of the second part where
he has opened a road upon his lands or
may hereafter open one but not to extend
further upon the lands of the party of the
first part than as heretofore used for

such road.

The said party of the first part also conveys to said party of the second part a right to use the well of water upon the lands of the said party of the first part as heretofore described for himself & his heirs as heretofore used by and for the accommodation of the persons occupying the house now owned by said party of the second part. said party of the second part to pay one half of the expenses of keeping said well & apparatus in repair
