Part of 36 Cherry Street (R6)



From Red Hook Historical Guide: On early maps, Cherry Street is called "The Path that Goeth into the Woods." This winding narrow street was one of the main east-west links between the western Connecticut settlements and the Hudson River Landings. It was important as a trade route. There are several old houses still standing which go back to the early settlement of the village.

Bassett: Cherry Lane, NE sector of RH is oldest section, as the street names haven't changed since before 1865.
