Dear Winthrop:

I traced Albert Cole farm rather quickly back to Andrew Teator and I drew a sketch of the 190 acres. Of special interest the sketch shows location of the "Old Indian Camping Ground."

I wasted too much time trying to locate how Andrew got the farm. You will note the parcels of 105 and 11 1/4 acres are similar and similar to the west boundaries of the 190 acre farm/ and the 81 acre parcel is similar to the east part of the 190 acre farm.

I then found a purchase by Hendrick Teator in 1754 and made sketch of that. There doesn't seem to much similarity to that one and the 190 acre one.

Then I happened to think that Clara Losee may have done work on the Teator family. I called her and met her at Milan Town Hall and obtained 4 pages of Teator family. She thinks Albert Cole farm is same as Hendrick bought in 1754 with some additions and there is a star by the person that probably inherited the farm.

### LUTHERAN CHURCH, RED HOOK

**CLASSIFICATION:** Churchyard.

**LOCATION:** St. Paul's Church (Evangelical Lutheran), village of Red Hook.

**CONDITION:** Entirely neglected.

**INSCRIPTIONS:** 340 in number. Copied August 4, 1914, by J. W. Poucher, M. D., Mrs. Poucher and Miss M. O. Johnston.

**REMARKS:** About the year 1800 members of the German Reformed Church of Pink's Corners (town of Rhinebeck), four miles south of the village of Red Hook, built a new church at Red Hook. Before long the new congregation at Red Hook absorbed the remnants of the older one at Pink's Corners and the latter passed out of existence as a separate unit. Some years later the German Reformed Church at Red Hook became affiliated with this Lutheran congregation and as a Lutheran Church the two have continued in one corporate existence.

To sisters, Ann and Catharine, and above nieces my wearing apparel. Upon death or remarriage of wife executors to sell real estate and dispose of proceeds as follows: £200 to be "deemed as part of and subject to alike dispositions with my residuary estate"; £30 for son William "in consideration of his imbecillity"; remainder equally divided between sons Henry, William and Philip. Remainder of estate on death or remarriage of wife to be divided in 17 parts, one seventeenth part for son John, and two seventeenth parts each to other children, viz.: Zacharias, Abraham, Henry, William, Philip, Margaret, Elizabeth and Catharine. If I die possessed of considerable cash more than sufficient for the reasonable subsistence of my wife and such of my children as choose to remain with her the surplus to be divided at once among my children.

I leave to my wife, Martha Keen, income of all houses, lands and meadows while my widow, also forever one bed and £50; if needful for better support of my wife and family my executors to allow her a further supply out of my money at interest. To two daughters, Mary and Martha, £150, and at death of mother my household stuff. To son Isaac, £100, half of all my houses and buildings, lands and personal estate not disposed of, and to my executors the remaining half for the following purpose: "first in case my son, Thomas Keen, should forsake leave of and refrain from his loose and evil practices so as to become and continue a sober and

frugal husband of his affairs and the business of this life and that my executors are fully satisfied of his reformation by a suteable time of probation then." Executors to yield him his share as above; but if son Thomas "continues in his present loose condition," then executors to give him such help from time to time as is needful, but property to go to son Isaac.

To Martha Vachte, one feather bed, pillows, sheets, blankets, etc., and two cows, on condition she continue in my family till 21 years of age or marriage, "behaving herself well." The George Teator property was south of Red Hook, near the Lown farm; Frederick Teator is located in the same area.

*From Chain Line*  
Hendrick Teator had leased at least two parcels of land from the Van Benthuyssen family prior to 1748 in what is now Red Hook. The property would have been on the Post Road, one parcel of 88 acres West of the Post Road and adjoining the Sawkill. This parcel was sold to Hendrick Martin in 1756. Henry Teator also purchased land in what is now known as Upper Red Hook. In 1767 he purchased from Peter Van Benthuyssen 164 acres, the deed stating that the property is "now in possession of Henrick Teeter", except lot leased to Andries Drom is to continue and also except 3 acres which Peter Van Benthuyssen had sold to John Van Ness. A deed dated May 11, 1756, Peter Kool to Henderick Teeter for forty morgans or eighty acres of land, has been in the possession of the Teator family for several generations. Peter Kool had purchased the lease of Jacob Drom, Margriet his wife, and Johannis Drom, heirs of Andries Drom, dated March 25, 1722 from Capt. Barent Van Benthuyssen. (Jacob Drom is only son of Andries Drom; Johannis Drom is son of Jacob and Margriet Drom). The 80 acres mentioned in the lease are part of the 164 acres purchased in 1767 for 143 Pounds. \* Lease

To date no positive record as to the parents of Hendrick Teator have been found. There are records of the West Camp Lutheran Church which give information about George Teator, Lawrence Teator, and Johannes Teator. There are also records for a Henry Teator, married November 24, 1747 to Beletje Neher which indicate that he is the son of Jury Teator and his wife Anna Maria Meyer. His children have as sponsors George and Anna Maria, and also Frans Neher and wife Rebecca, parents of Beletje Neher.

Since there do not appear to be any Teator sponsors at the baptism of Hendrick and Catharine Benner Teator's children, it could be assumed that his parents were deceased. And since his first child, Anna Margaret was born about 1740, it is entirely possible that his parents could have been Lawrence and Margreeta Teator. A further search of church records may give proof.

In 1771 Zacharia Teeter and wife Elizabeth, son of Hendrick and Catharine Benner, had a lease of 209 acres, less 50 acres which had been leased to John Fulton. This property is on the road East from Upper Red Hook and adjoins the property of the Fulton Homestead. Abraham Teator also lived in the same area.
