Clarence Shook was born in Red Hook. He served in the Civil War until April, 1865. He was aboard the U. S. Steam Frigate "Colorado" in Mobile Bay at Mobile, Alabama, in October, 1863 and was with the Western Gulf Blockading Squadron. H was the first bookkeeper of the Firs National Bank to be elected a Director, which promotion came in 1878 He served the bank as its Cashie from 1893 to 1904.

Mr. Shook was a man possessed of a charming personality and was deep ly interested in the affairs of Rel Hook. He co-operated in the better ment of community conditions and in so doing, won and held a large circle of friends.
