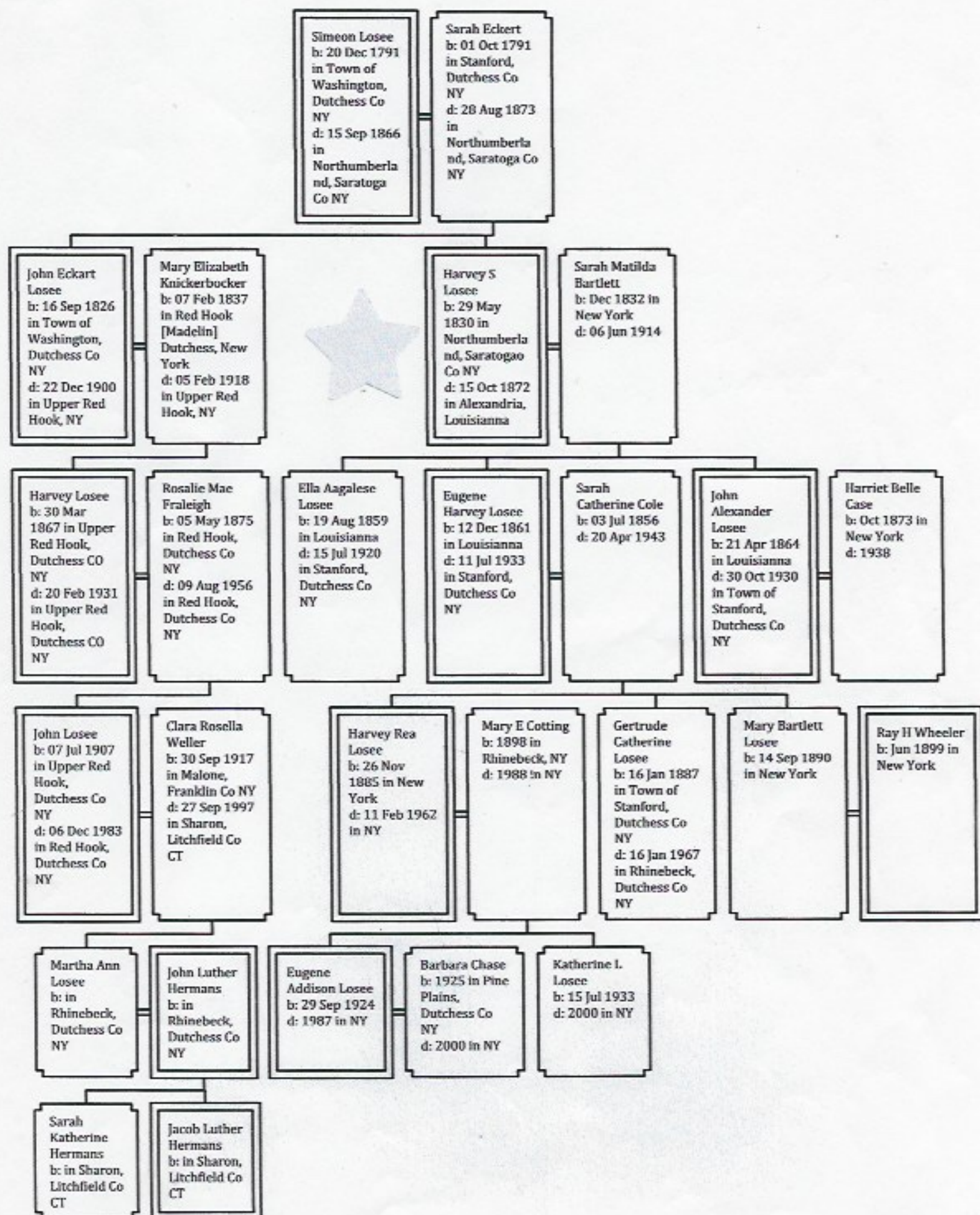

Dr. John Eckert Losee – b. 9-16-1826, Saratoga Co., graduated from Albany Medical College in 1852; served seven mo. At Old New York Hospital. Came to Upper Red Hook in Dec. 1853. Joined SJ 1858, deacon 1862, elder 1874; Joined Dr. Gamaliel Wheeler. Succeeded to the practice on Dr. Wheeler's death in 1859. Also succeeded the practice of Dr. Allaben. Practiced for 47 years. d. 12-22-1900

m. 6-26-1862 Mary Elizabeth Knickerbocker b. 2-7-1837 in Madelin, d. 2-5-1918 in Red Hook, daughter of Edwin Knickerbocker (see Knickerbockers) and Eliza A. Beckwith, taught boys Sunday School class.
