ACKER OR ECKERT LINE

Rupp's 30.000 Names p 446 list of those living at Livingston Manor. N.Y. in 1710 - One Nicholous Eckert. Smith p 194: Nicklaus Eckard was in Queensbury, one of the German Camps in Columbia County in 1711. Hartford Times of June 18, 1960 states he may have been the father of Adam Eckert.

ADAM ACKER born about 1690 in Palatinate of Germany, died near Rhinebeck. N.Y. (No date found.) Came from Germany via England in 1710/11 and settled by Gov. Robert Hunter upon lands on the Hudson River. He married in 1711 Anna Rouw. Smith's History of Rhinebeck p 229: He built a stone house, known as Abram Brown house in 1719. P 46: he was on the tax list of the North Ward in 1723 as freeholder. P 123 the name was spelled Ackert, Ecker, Eykert, Acquert etc. Record was found of two children, perhaps there were more.

In NYG&B v 84 p 49 his wife is called "Grietie" which would be a nickname for Margaritje. Their children were all bp. at the Dutch Reformed Church, Rhinebeck Flats, which is in Dutchess County, NY.
