Note: Most of the land in Red Hook in the early years was held under lease to Gen. John Armstrong whose wife was Alida Livingston, being an heir of Margaret Beekman Livingston. The farm of Peter I. Ackert mentioned in this file is probably in the south part of Red Hook, west of the present Rte 9 and close to the Rhinebeck border.

I can find nothing on the Waters name or the baptisms of his daughters Julia and Kate. There may have been some of Kelly's records that I have overlooked as in the early 1800's people were married and baptized at different churches where ever a minister would be.
