Joseph D. Babinsky Jr.

PITTSFIELD TOWNSHIP—Joseph D. Babinsky Jr., 61, of Pittsfield Township, formerly of Lorain, died Saturday, Jan. 22, 2005, in the emergency room at Allen Medical Center, Oberlin, after being stricken with an apparent heart attack.

He was born Sept. 6, 1943, in Lorain, and moved to Pittsfield Township 27 years ago.

He was a graduated from Lorain High School in 1961.

Babinsky was employed for 23 years at American Ship Building Co., Lorain, as a machinist first class, and served served as a union steward. Upon the closing of AmShip, he worked for Nordson Corp. from 1984 to 2001 as a fork lift operator and most recently had been as a machine operator the Diamond Products Co., Elyria.
