Funeral services for Mrs. Marilyn G. Jensen, aged 23, wife of Airman Second Class Rolland I. Jensen of Scott AFB at Belleville, who dies unexpectedly at four a.m. Thursday in their home at Shiloh, Ill., were held at two p.m. Sunday at the Albany Methodist Church. The Rev.
