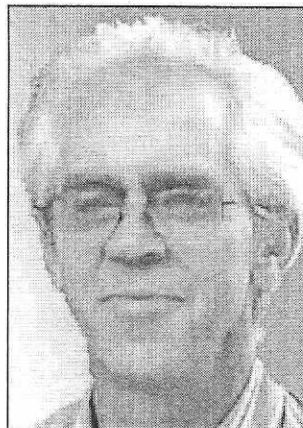

Andy was born in Baltimore, MD to Mildred Marie (Groves) and Aaron Goodloe Anderson. He passed away peacefully at home surrounded by his loving family. After graduation from High School in Lorain, Ohio, Andy joined the Air Force in 1961 and proudly served his country as an electrician. Reenlisting in 1965 at Westover AFB, Massachusetts in 1965 and serving 1 tour of duty in Viet Nam during 1967-68. Andy was honorably discharged from the Air Force in 1969 from McChord AFB, WA and in 1969 Andy began working for St. Regis Lumber Company in Tacoma, WA as a maintenance electrician, retiring from Simpson Lumber Company in 2009. He had a very strong work ethic and was very passionate about his work and dedicated to his job.

Andy was a special person, who was very proud of his family where he was a great mentor and influence in their lives and the lives of those that knew him. He was funny, patient, brilliant and loyal.
