On December 16 th, 1995 Joe his wife Julie, and a friend of theirs, Rupert Moralis were on their way down the Baja Peninsula from their home in San Diego to some property that they had. They had been working on it every chance they got, long weekends, holidays, any time they could get away for a few days, they went down and worked on the house, and the bunkhouse. My brother was hoping to get it up and running as a place for people to come and stay and he would take them out on hunting trips. Anyway it was early morning, and they weren't far from their destination, and they were hit straight on by a 15 ton Kenworth. No one really knows the particulars of the accident, as the truck driver jumped from his truck and ran. My brother, his wife, and their friend were all burnt, as their vehicle burst into flames. My brother Wayne and I went to California the following July and found a friend of Joe's and he drove us to where he and his wife are buried.

I miss him everyday, there were 5 boys and 1 girl, and that girl was me. In the years that have gone by, my brother Wayne, and my brother Tom have passed from Alzheimer's. The two oldest brothers, Gary and Ray are the ones that I'm blessed enough to still have.
