5 Boys Drown In Lorain County; 3 Are Brothers

A Lorain attorney's son and a North Olmsted youth lost their lives in separate drowning accidents in Lorain County near the Memorial Day weekend.

JOHN PROVENZA, 15, son of Mrs. Joseph and Mrs. J. of 1418 E. 14th St., died Sunday morning, June 1, 1959, at 10:30 a.m. after drowning in the nearby river about a mile south of his home.
