



## JAMES T. "JIM" BROWN



James T. "Jim" Brown, age 74 and a resident of Amherst, passed away Wednesday, October 25, 2017, at Mercy New Life Hospice, Lorain, after a two year illness. Jim was born in Lorain April 18, 1943, where he was raised and graduated from Lorain High School. Jim served in the United States Army from 1961-1964. He made Amherst his home for the past 14 years. Jim was a City of Lorain firefighter and paramedic for over 20 years. After retiring, Jim was a real estate salesperson and managed apartment buildings. In his younger years, Jim loved to take his dad fishing to West Virginia. In later years he loved to cook. Most especially, throughout his life he had several pet dogs, his last being his beloved "Sassy".

Jim was a member of the Roman Catholic Church of St. Peter, Lorain, and was a 32 degree mason with the Black River Lodge, Lorain and the Scottish Rite.
