Death of Henry P. Cartier

Henry P. Cartier, one of the best known and old residents of Independence, died Monday night at 11:30 o'clock and was buried from the I. O. O. F. cemetery Wednesday morning. Judge A. V. Davidson officiating.

Mr. Cartier had been ailing for many months and his death was expected. He came to this country 38 years ago and has been engaged in mining most of the time. He was well known and highly respected, having a host of friends who mourn his death.

He was unmarried and leaves one brother, Philip Cartier, in Independence.

He was a native of St. George, Canada, aged 73 years.
