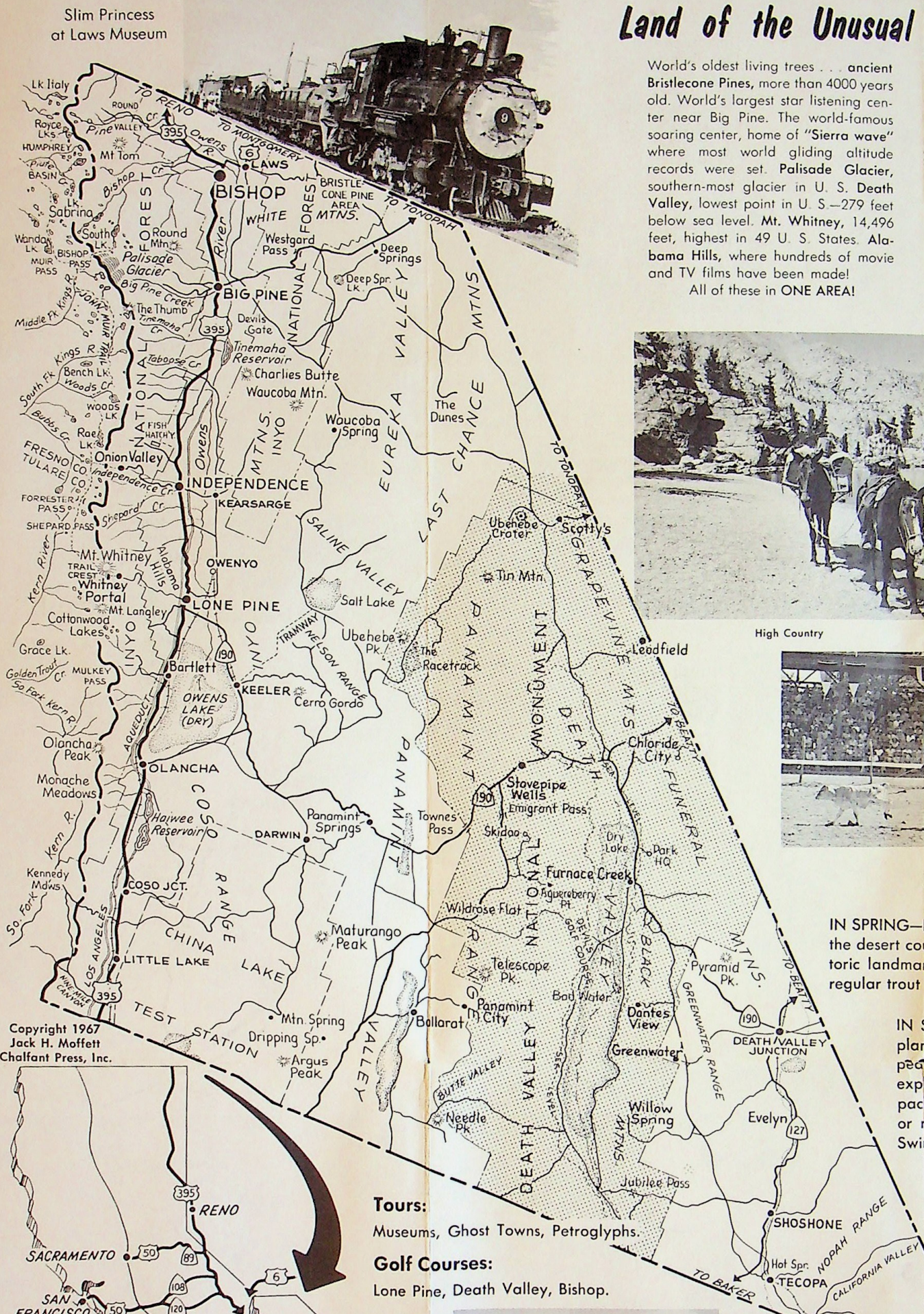


## Land of the Unusual

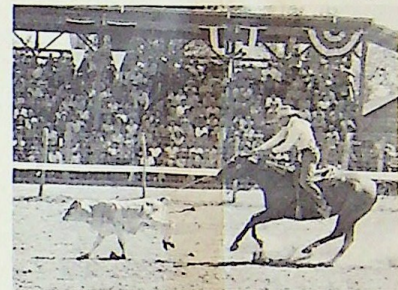
