

The trip in and out represents a total of fifty-six miles, every foot of which, save only two miles where a dry lake-bed was crossed, was low-gear work, because of grade or roadbed or both. It was accomplished at sizzling Death Valley temperatures—on five gallons of gasoline, five gallons of radiator water, and less than one quart of oil!


