not show up, he was supposed to speak)

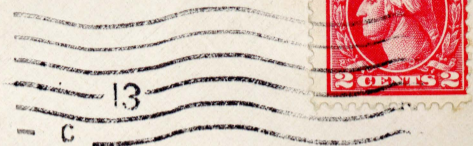
The cabinet as a whole don't
