### *Chorus*

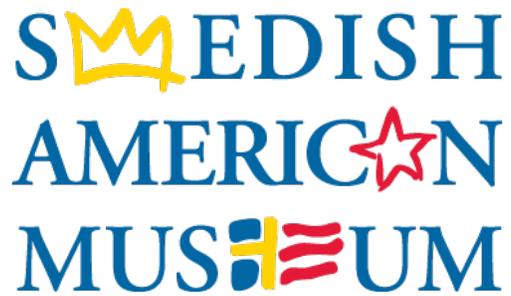
Oh Delta Tau, thy sacred vow
