Witnesseth: The said CHAS. G. BLAKE & CO. agree to furnish and set complete, upon foundation provided by said Chas. G. Blake Co.

in Graceland Cemetery a Memorial and two headstones, and re-cut the lettering on the three headstones now on the lot of best Barre, Vt. Granite in accordance with design 7440 S A

of CHAS. G. BLAKE & CO.'S Collection, and which forms a part of this agreement, the general dimensions of the same being 7 feet 6 onches long, 4 feet 3 inches wide and 5 feet 7 inches high. The memorial to be all fine patent hammered. The four corners of the cap to be carved in relief in an artistic manner. The name SAMUEL E. ERICKSON to be carved on the front in incised letters. A full size detail to be submitted for approval.

The headstones to be 24 inches wide 12 inches thick and the regulation height allowed by the cemetery.

All the material and workmanship shall be of the best quality. To be completed on or about April 15, 1924.

And in Consideration, of the faithful performance of the foregoing, the said Samuel E. Erickson

hereby agrees to pay to the order of CHAS. G. BLAKE & CO. the sum of (\$2840.00) Twenty-eight Hundred and forty - - - - -00/100 Dollars Seven hundred dollars on or about Jan. 10, 1924 and the balance
