NOTICE

It is unlawful to take, or attempt to take, any variety of bass, any variety of trout (except lake trout), crappies, sunfish, bluegills, pickerel, or wall-eyed pike, except with hooks and lines. Pole and line devices must be under the immediate control of the fisherman. Fish may be taken with hook and line only, within 100 feet of a dam.

It is unlawful to take fish, in a Fish Preserve, except by means of pole and line or trot lines.
 Minnows shall not be used as bait on any trot, set or throw line from March 1 to May 31, both inclusive.

It is necessary to secure the consent of the owner or person in charge to fish in privately owned waters.
