It is Further Ordered, That all cases remanded to this court by a court of review, which have by order of this court been redocketed, pursuant to the mandate filed, whether upon a trial calendar according to custom or not, shall upon notice by either party be advanced and set for trial at as early a date as possible by the Judge upon whose calendar such case appears, or if the remanded case is upon no trial calendar, then the same shall be set for trial by the Head of the Law Division, upon the call of such Judge to whom such case is assigned who may find it convenient to try the same.

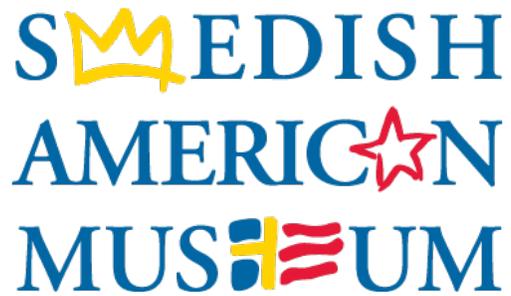
