Dear Bro Joe,

Will now scribble a few lines to you. I am well and hope this finds you and the rest the same. I am writing these lines in the room at Trier, Germany. Just got thru eating a few sandwiches and drinking a cup of cocoa, some feed kid. This is the first time I ever wrote a letter on Red Cross stationery. I never got a hold of any before but Joe the Red Cross is great, done us a heap of good served us hot drinks, cookies, candies while on the front, and now they are doing the same thing. I say "God Bless them."

I'm on my way to join the company again I heard my elbow playing football and I can't use my left arm very much. We won 2 games, 1st 6-0, second 30-0 we are champions of the 7th corp. If we win the game next Thurs we are Army champs. Then
