

PLANS for the celebration of the twentieth anniversary of the founding of the Odin Club Male Chorus are now under way. When our next fall concert comes around we expect to do retrospecting and reminiscing to the tune of twenty years.

Almost two decades of active chorus existence is something to be proud of, but when one considers that this organization has from the very outset included men from all the various Scandinavian countries—Sweden, Norway, Denmark, Finland and Iceland, the record becomes quite remarkable. Here is a case of harmonious co-operation among these national groups which may well be considered unique. We owe the European countries much for the musical heritage they have given us, but are we not possibly repaying to some degree such debts by our example to Europe of friendly co-operation in song? Minneapolis has been termed "the singingest city in the world". The Odin Chorus feels proud that it has contributed its mite to warrant such a designation for its home town.

It is a special pleasure and honor to welcome as our guest chorus at this concert the Svithiod Singing Club of Chicago. For fifty-nine years this organization of men of Swedish extraction has maintained a high standard of choral excellence. Similar exchange appearances have in recent years been made with the Liederkranz Chorus of Milwaukee and the Amphion Chorus of Fargo-Moorhead.

We humbly submit to our friends and associates that our past performances as well as our aims and plans for the future should warrant a continuation of your patronage. We are deeply grateful for everything. May our song give you much pleasure.


