Dear William

arrived here yesterday
from Marseille Duvy, all day
visiting places of historic
interest, tomorrow I will
visit some of the great battle
fields of the late war
at Rheims, Chateau Thierry
Bellevue wood, Fismes, and
other battle fields.

Paris has grown to be a big
City since I was here in 1881.
I have had a wonderful
time. I left the Steamer
at Villefranche to give me
an opportunity to visit
places like Monte Carlo
Nice and Marseille. France
I enclose you a postal Card

from Monte Carlo, this and
Manaco Nice and Marseille
The scenery around the bay
of these places are indescrib-
able. I passed the harbor
of the Prince who governs ~~the~~
Monte Carlo and Manaco
I saw about one thousand
people men and women
gamble around the tables
I am traveling with Minister
Rus J. R. Dallas of Akron Ohio
we left the boat the same
time and have been
traveling together all of the
time we will leave
in a few days for London
and intend to go to Glasgow
Scotland before returning
home and also spend
about three days in London
The boat leaves Southampton

April 4th I stopped at
Cherbourg France on way
to New York. I have a very
fine cabin in the steamer
I left one of my suitcases
in the Laconia with
instruction to recheck
the same on the Berengaria
steamer. It would have
been too much trouble
to take both suitcases along
I expect to reach New York
about the 10th of April
on my arrival I will
telegraph the girls to
meet me at the depot
if the car is still good
and going I do not
know if I will spend
a day with Mr Gundlach
I suppose that I will
be glad to get home as soon
as possible

I do not think I will
write any more letters
home ~~as~~ it is possible
I may get home as soon
as this letter. The time
is too short I will
possibly send a few
more Postal Cards
from London. I hope
that everything is all
right at home and
that Grand Ma is feeling
better than she did when
I left on my tour
I stopped at this Hotel
in Marseille
