## On to the Chicago Convention in '66!

### MEDINAH TEMPLE

Site of

Convention Grand Concert

Friday, Evening, July 8, 1966



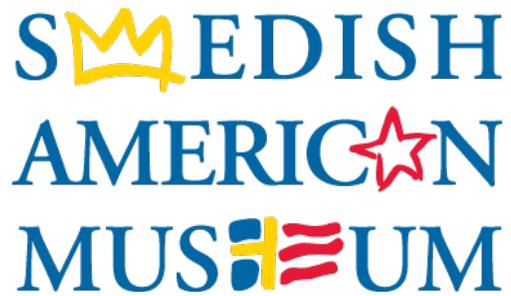
MEDINAH TEMPLE has been chosen as the site of the 1966 AUSS convention Grand Concert on Friday, July 8. The Auditorium seats approximately 4,100 persons on three floors, Main floor, Dress Circle and Balcony. Visibility and acoustics are excellent and the stage is 68 x 68 feet, large enough to accommodate the entire Shrine Circus. The stage has a steel fire curtain, besides draw type curtains and various backdrops.

The Temple is entirely air-conditioned, with separate

units for the Auditorium and the Banquet Hall, which has a capacity for serving about 2,500 persons.

The Auditorium has an exceptionally fine pipe organ and there is a built-in sound system with various connections for portable microphones. Various colored floodlights are mounted on the edge of the balcony for lighting the stage.

Medinah Temple is within easy walking distance of the Sheraton-Chicago Hotel, the Convention headquarters.
