of which I sent you a postal
Theater of Dionysius very

interesting also. Temple Jupiter
I stood on Hill of Mars
where apostle Paul spoke
to the Greek people
I hope that you will be
able someday to visit
these wonderful places of
interest. The museum here
contains some beautiful
work of sculpture of
ancient days
I also visited one of the old
Cemetery's where prominent
men of the early centuries
are buried. I expect to
visit many places in
Constantinople of surpassing
interest like the Aya Sophia
Masque, Sultan Selim Tombs

Pyramid of Constantine
Serpant Column and Museum
of Antiquities I sent
28 postal cards from Athens
and will probably mail
some more from Constantinople
The weather and the sea
has been pleasant and
favorable on my journey
so far, which helps to make
the trip enjoyable
It seems like I have been
away from home about
a year or more but the
time appears to go by
so fast that I hardly
realize that I have been

away from Chicago so long
I have mailed Grandma
a letter from every port
we land and hope that
she is getting along
nicely there is something
going on all the time
on the boat there are
about 700 people on
the steamer I have appeared
number of times on the program
I hope that everything
is moving along as usual
at home
