

Archbishop Nathan Söderblom,*

the best known churchman, one of the foremost university men, is the recognized leader in the Protestant world Today. Born at Trönö, Gefleborgs Län, Jan. 15, 1866, where his father was Provost, he studied at Hudiksvall and was ready for the University at the age of 17. He became Candidate of Philosophy in 1886, Candidate of Theology in 1892, and was ordained in 1893.

In 1894, Nathan Söderblom became pastor of the Swedish church in Paris and Seaman's pastor for the Ports of Northern France. During 1896-1898 he pursued his studies at the University of Paris and received the degree of Doctor of Theology in 1901.

That same year he was called to the chair of History and Philosophy of religion at Leiden. A call also came from the University of Upsala. This was accepted, together with that of pastor for the Holy Trinity Church. While occupying this chair, Theological Encyclopedia, at Upsala, he also occupied that of History of Religion at the University of Leipsig. Nathan Söderblom became Archbishop in 1914.

The Archbishop is a prodigious writer. He is the recognized leader in the movement for world peace and church unity.

He received the Honorary Degree of Doctor of Divinity from the University of Geneva, 1909; of Christiana, 1911; of St. Andrews, 1911. He received the Honorary Degree of Doctor of Philosophy from Upsala, 1917, and from a large number of universities throughout the world, including that of Oxford.



Instructions to Canvassers

Canvass every separate home in the section assigned to you.

Be sure to canvass every flat or apartment in each building.

In every case of doubt make careful inquiry as to possible location of additional homes,—upstairs, downstairs, in the rear, etc.

Complete a card for each family.

Complete a separate card for each roomer.

Complete a separate card for each servant.

If more than one denomination is represented in a family, complete a separate card for each denomination.

If children attend a Sunday School of a different denomination than parents' church preference, complete separate card for children, but also make notation on back of family card.

If cases of distress are discovered make notation of facts on back of card.


If desire is expressed for a pastoral call, or a willingness indicated to join any church or Sunday School, make notation on back of card.

In cases where no one is at home, will you please make a second call, if possible?

Take time to be thorough. Answer all questions on each card. Look over your cards carefully and be sure no information is omitted.

When your canvass is completed return all cards to your Ward or District Chairman immediately.
