My mouth is watering for that coffee now and dear, don't forget the dill pickles.

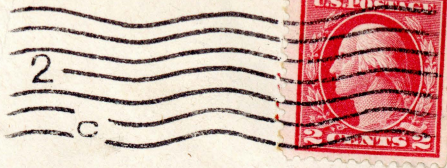
