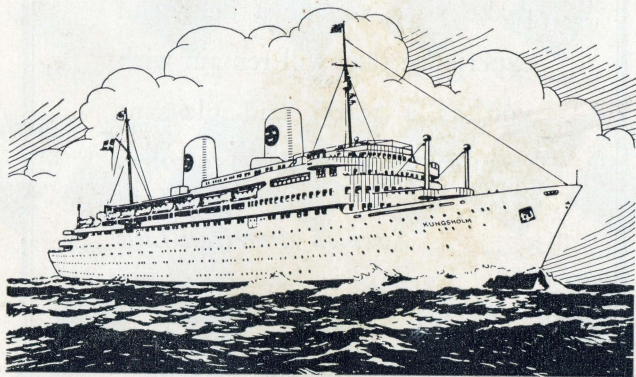

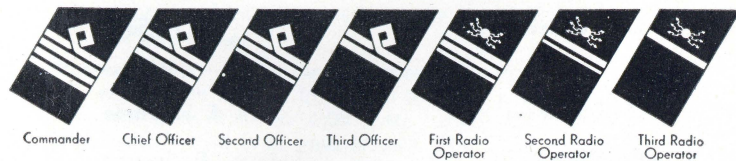

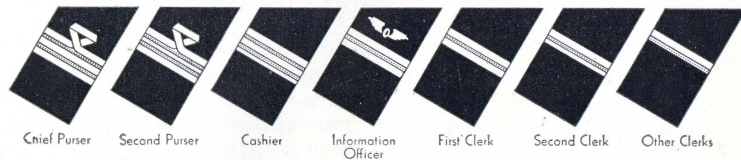

Bon Voyage!

Information That Will Help You on Your Trip—You'll get the most "bon" out of your "voyage" if you avail yourself of all the many pleasant facilities that this modern luxury liner has to offer you. When the ship has set sail, settle down comfortably in your deck chair or your stateroom with this book and familiarize yourself with all the conveniences at your command, with the suggestions for your comfort and safety. Keep this little book handy, so you will know where to find whatever you want. Any information omitted here you can get from your stateroom steward or the Purser's Office. And if you have any suggestions for improving service on the KUNGS HOLM, or have any complaints, the Purser is the man to see.

Purser's Office—Upper Deck, Forward. The Purser's Office is open from 9:00 to 10:00 A.M. and from 2:30 to 4:00 P.M., where the Purser's staff is at your service. The Chief Purser is available personally for consultation from 9:30 to 10:30 A.M., in his office.



Information Officer—The ship's Information Officer will be glad to assist you with advice on travel regulations and other information you may need. See the KUNGS HOLM Bulletin Boards for when and where you may consult him.

Interpreter—Among the ship's personnel are persons who speak all the Scandinavian tongues as well as German, French and many other languages. Consult the Purser or Information Officer if you need language help.

Money Exchange—Money may be exchanged at the Purser's Office between 9:00 and 10:00 A.M. and from 2:30 to 4:00 P.M. Due to currency regulations now in force, dollars cannot be given in exchange for other currencies. However, Swedish kroner as well as U. S. and Canadian dollars may be used to pay bills incurred aboard ship. Passengers are respectfully advised that the Purser's Office is not permitted to accept or cash personal checks.

Deck Chairs—Deck chairs may be obtained from the Deck Steward and steamer rugs rented at the rate of \$1.00 per rug for the voyage. Carrying stateroom blankets and pillows on deck is not permitted.

Meal Hours—Perhaps the sweetest music on the KUNGS HOLM is the dinner gong to meals. Your prompt appearance will make for better service, and will win you the appreciation of the Dining Room Staff. Dining Room is on A-deck, Forward.

Special diets may be arranged with the Head Waiter.

Seating Arrangements—Your place at table will be assigned by the Chief Steward, immediately after sailing.

Room Service—Room Service is available throughout the day—just call your room steward by pressing the proper button at the head of your bed behind the bed curtain.



Night Service—Room stewards go off duty 10:00 P.M. For stateroom service between 10:00 P.M. and 7:00 A.M., simply call Night Service—just dial 379 on your room telephone.

Bars—Bars on the ship are open during hours posted at the Bars and on the ship's Bulletin Boards.

Electric Razors—Among the conveniences the KUNGS HOLM provides is an outlet for your electric razor. However, electric irons are under no circumstances to be used in staterooms, as it may overload the circuit . . . and *ruin your iron!* (Ship's current is 220 volts D.C., and most American electrical appliances are wired for 110 volts only.) Therefore, for your convenience, we have installed a special . . .

Ironing Room—This convenient room is located on Upper Deck, Midships, adjoining the Shop in Tourist Class. It is open from 9:00 to 11:00 A.M. and from 3:00 to 5:00 P.M.

Pressing Business—Your room steward will see to any clothes pressing you need done.

Shave? Haircut?—The Barber Shop—fast service and experienced barbers—Entrance Midships on Main Deck. It is open from 9:00 A.M. to 1:00 P.M. and from 3:00 to 7:00 P.M.

Beauty Shop—Entrance Main Deck, Midships. The Beauty Shop offers complete facilities for keeping milady's face, hands and hair attractive for the ship's many social activities. Hours from 9:00 A.M. to 1:00 P.M. and from 3:00 to 7:00 P.M.



Air Conditioning—Your ship is air conditioned throughout to ensure comfortable temperature and air circulation everywhere in the ship irrespective of outside conditions.

In the staterooms the temperature as well as the air movement may be individually adjusted. The temperature is regulated by turning the small wheel on the thermostat in the stateroom. The air circulation is adjustable by turning the arrow-shaped indicator in the ceiling.

The temperature in the bathrooms or shower-rooms generally is kept some few degrees above the temperature of the staterooms. Regulation through a small wheel in the ceiling.

All adjustments take about half an hour to become effective.

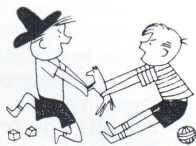
NOTE! The air circulation may be shut off altogether if desired, on request to your room steward who will also be glad to assist you in regulating the air conditioning.

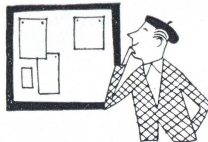

Shop—Beautiful Swedish glass, Danish porcelain, linens, sweaters and other distinctive gifts are on sale at the shop located on Upper Deck, Aft, and open from 9:00 A.M. to 12 NOON, and 3:00 to 6:00 P.M.

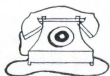
Your Pet—Dogs and other pets are well taken care of in special modern kennels. Only Seeing Eye dogs are allowed to be with their masters in staterooms.

Announcements—Get in the habit of looking at the ship's Bulletin Boards regularly for radio news and announcements of ship activities and other information of interest.



What's New?—Latest news and Stock Exchange prices, received by ship's radio, as well as special announcements, will be posted daily on the ship's Bulletin Boards. The KUNGS HOLM's route will be charted each day on a large map displayed in the vestibule on Verandah Deck, Aft.

Stateroom Phones—These phones may be used for calling your friends on board, for service, or for radio telephone calls. (See below.) If for any reason you wish to disconnect your phone, simply pull out the plug from the wall socket. The phone book provided in your room gives the numbers to passenger staterooms as well as the various ship's offices and services . . . Simply look up number and dial.



Wireless and Radio Telephone—The Radio Operator will send messages to the United States, Europe and other ships at sea. When atmospheric conditions are favorable, you may also telephone to the U. S. or Europe, or to other ships. If you wish to send a radiogram, please ask your room steward for blanks. He will take your message and collect the charge.

Typewriters—If you need one, ask at the Purser's Office.

Those Letters and Postcards—Letters from the United States, with U. S. stamps on them, mailed from the ship, must be left at the Purser's Office within half an hour after the

KUNGS HOLM leaves the pier, to be forwarded by the pilot from Ambrose Light. Other letters, with Swedish stamps, are to be left in the ship's mail box, and will be mailed from Sweden. You can buy stamps from the Deck Steward. Further information about mail is posted on the ship's Bulletin Boards.

Divine Service—Divine service will be held on Sundays and holy days. Notices of time and place will be posted on the Bulletin Boards.

The Ship's Doctor—The Doctor's office is on B-deck, Forward, and he may be consulted from 9:00 to 10:00 A.M. and from 4:30 to 5:30 P.M.

The KUNGS HOLM has a completely equipped modern hospital, with a staff of registered nurses.



What's an Aquasanium?—That's the place where you leave your tensions and extra poundage. You'll make good use of the gymnasiums, swimming pool, vapor room and electric heat cabinets. D-deck, Forward.

Auditorium—A-deck, Forward. Movies, lectures, theatricals and concerts are held here. Announcements on the ship's Bulletin Boards.

Read a Good Book—The Library, on Verandah Deck, Forward, provides books and magazines for your enjoyment. The Steward in attendance will be glad to help you find just the book you want.

Chess, Games, Cards—Chess and checker sets, dominoes and other games are obtainable without charge from the Deck

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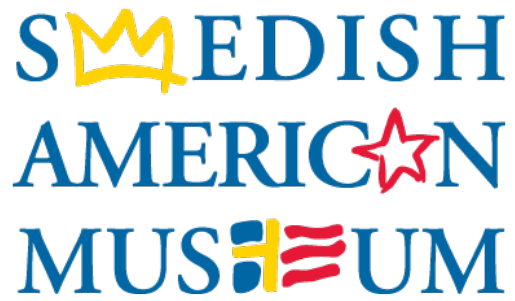
